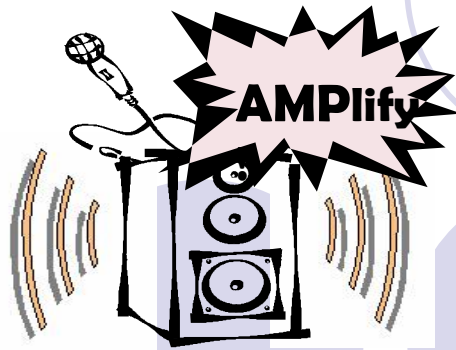

- We learn from each other and have fun!

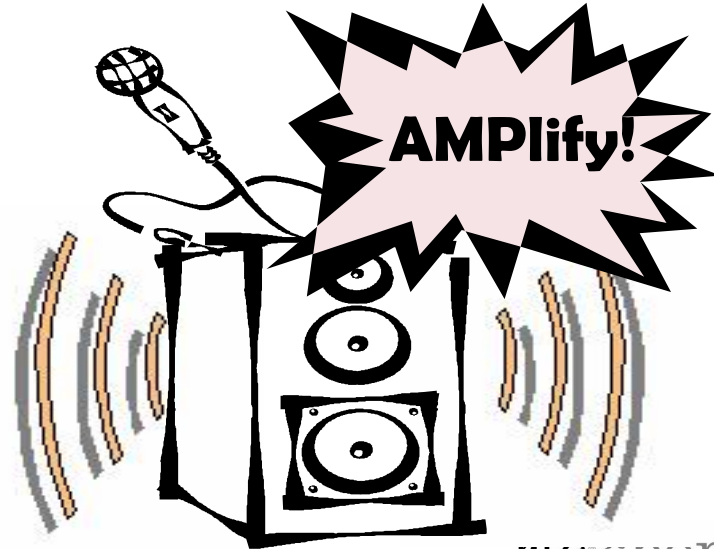

# AMP = Achieve My Plan

- AMP is a process for helping youth have a voice in their planning
  - IEP, wraparound, transition, etc.
- Plug into the process and your voice will be heard

# What exactly is AMP?

An “intervention” that is implemented for youth within an organization/agency/school

- AMP process with youth  
PLUS
- AMP organizational intervention
- Goal: to create change with least “burden”

# The AMP process with youth

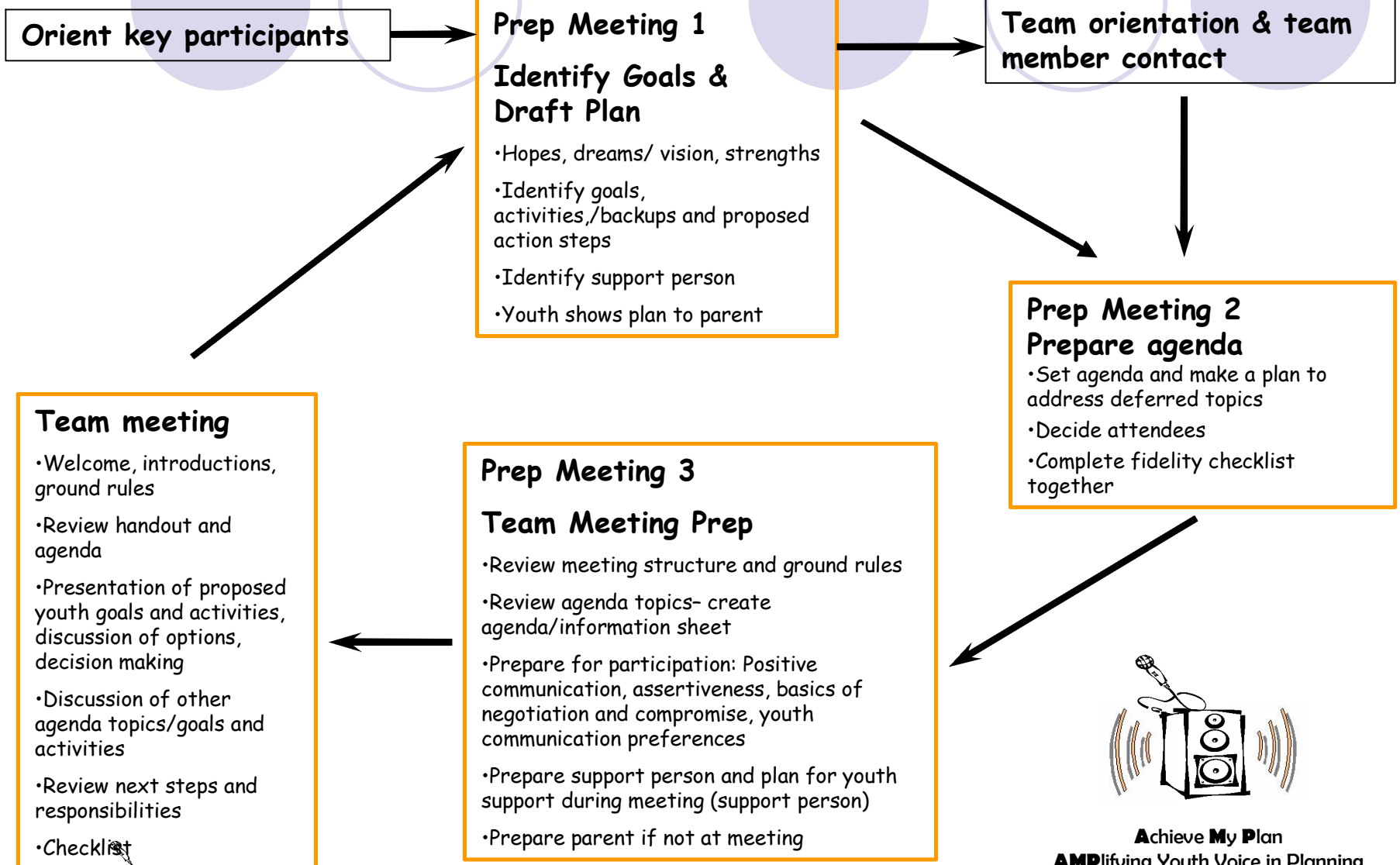
- During the weeks before a team planning meeting, youth has three meetings with a “prep person”
- One meeting also attended by a “support person” chosen by the youth
- Youth communicates with parents about the AMP process

- AMP at the organization/agency/school:  
Commitment to creating the climate and opportunities that encourage youth to participate in their meetings
- Training for staff
  - The value of youth participation- all staff training or web-based orientation
  - Role of “prep person”— training and support for staff doing the AMP process with youth
  - How to facilitate an AMP meeting—web-based tutorial on how to handle common problems
