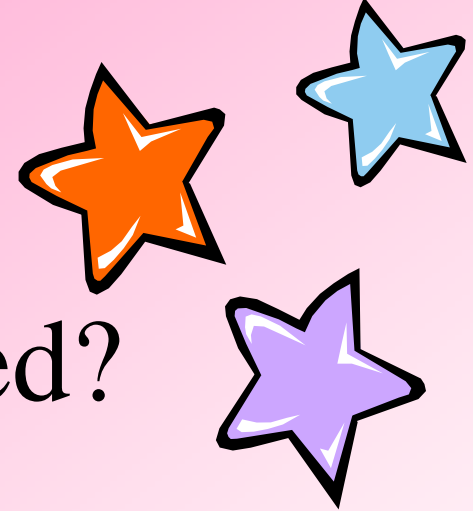

- Serving families in Benton/Franklin Counties
- Enrollment criteria
 - Under 18, major mental health diagnosis, current or past involvement with 2 systems.

- We all make mistakes, and everyone deserves a second chance.



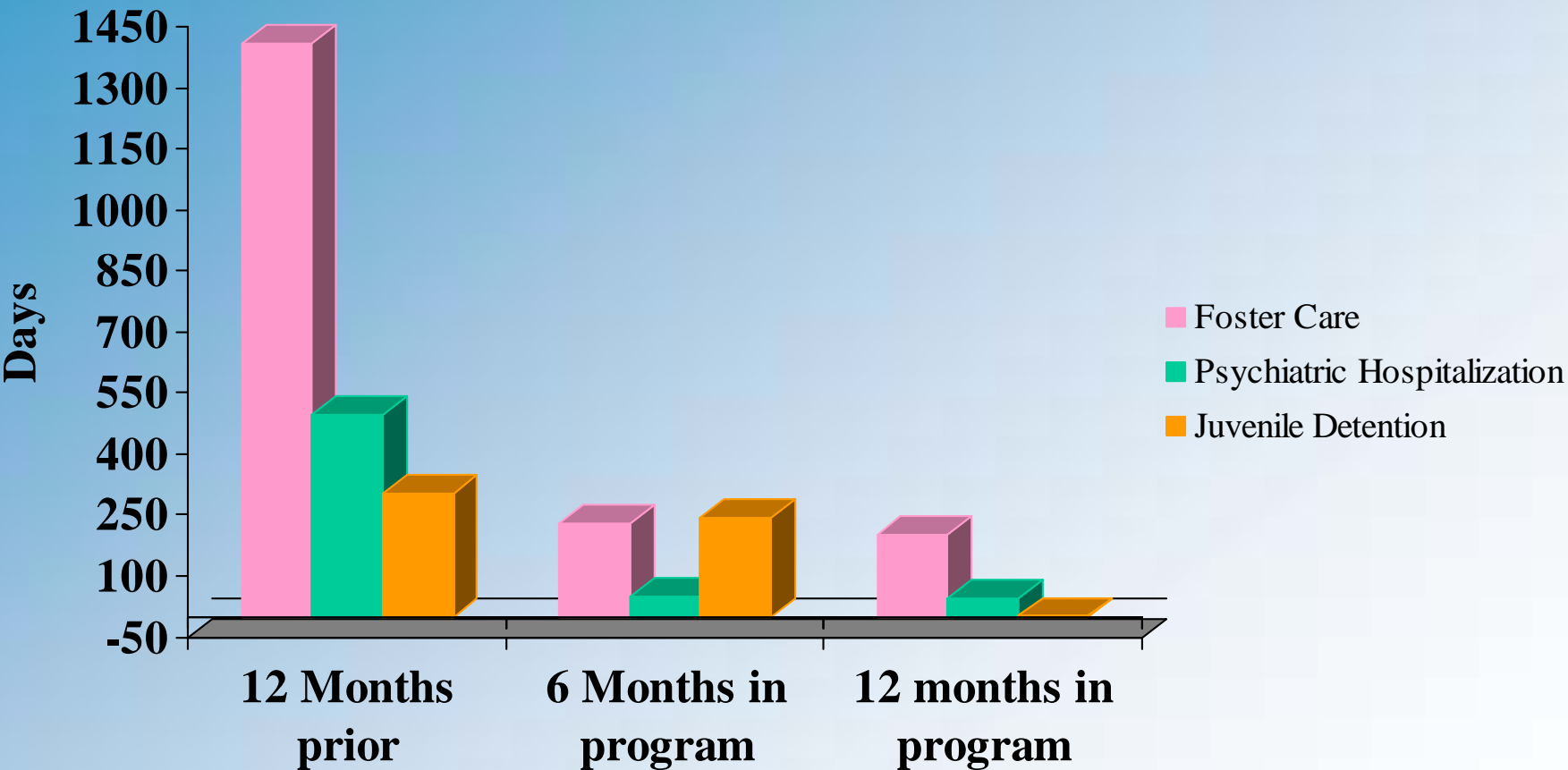

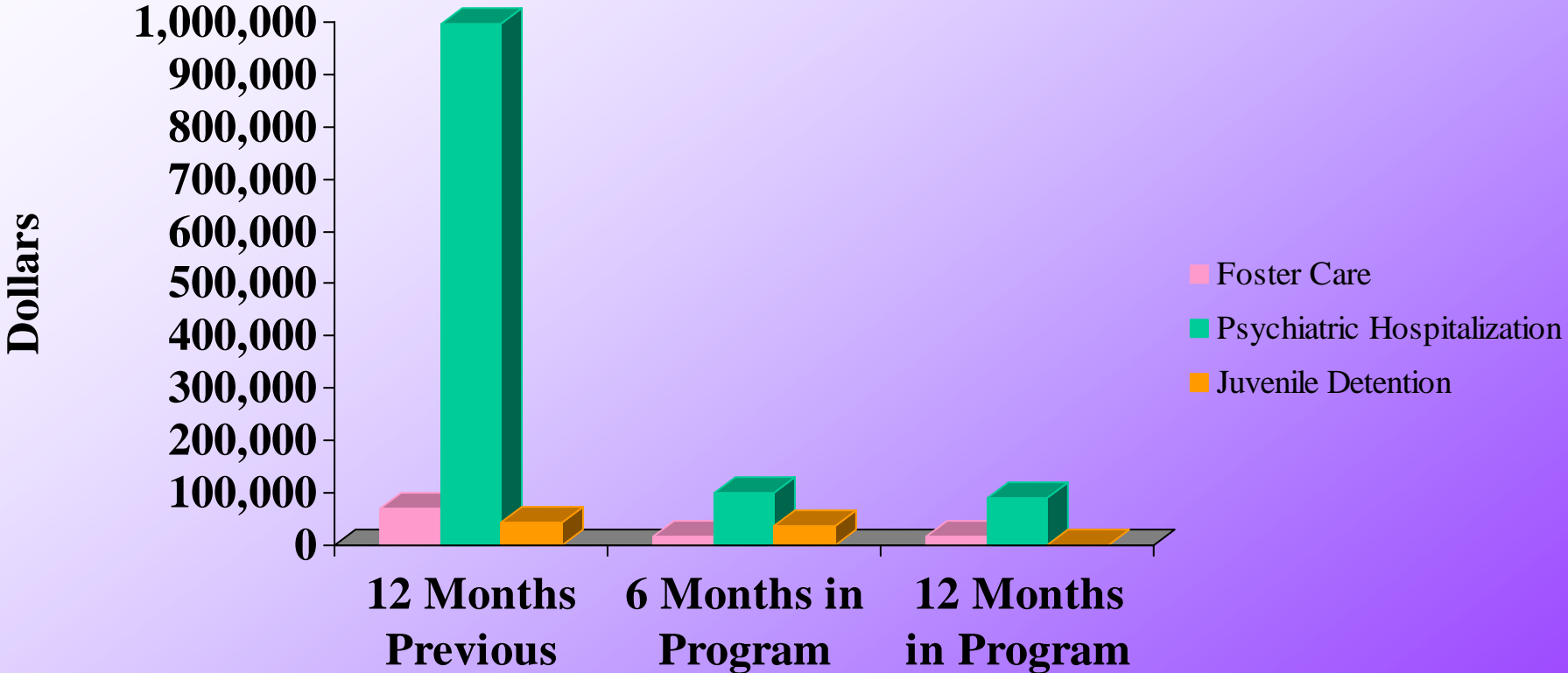

- ◇ The help we got to shape our family





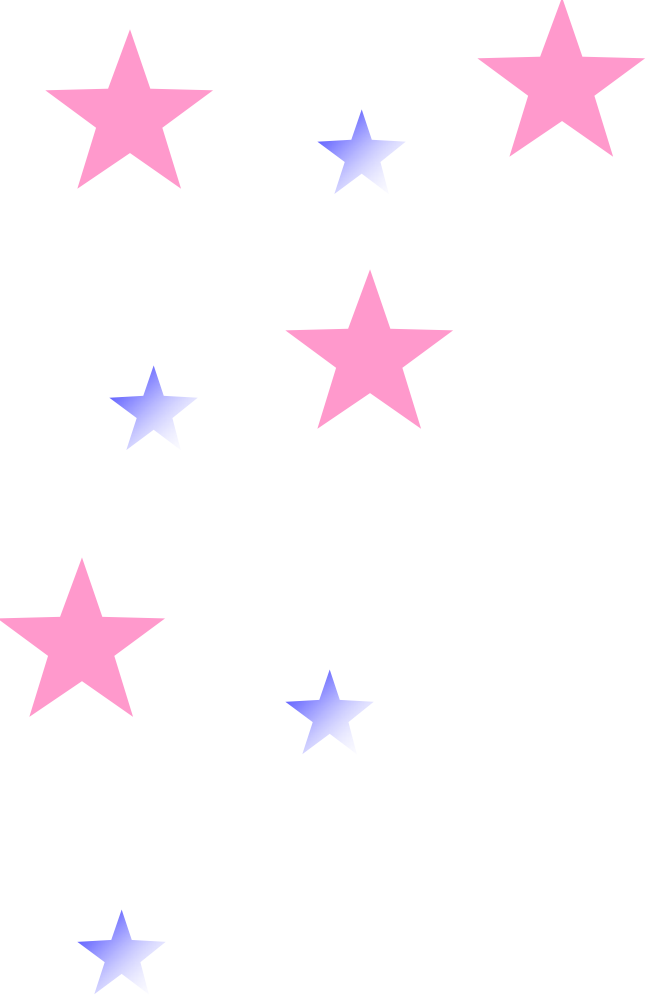
Meeting 3 Rivers
